Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to our 3rd Attendance newsletter.

Thank you to all of you who have ensured that your child(ren) are in school and on time. This is a great help in ensuring your child achieves their full potential and we are grateful for your support in doing this. The classes who have won the weekly Attendance cup have all enjoyed playing classopoly and winning extra house points and extra playtime.

Attendance Data – From Sept to Dec 2019

- Whole school attendance 95.66%. – Nearly there. Our whole school target is 96%.
- The class with the highest attendance is 4JS with 96.74% - Well done!
- The percentage of pupils who have achieved at least 96% is unfortunately just 61%. The target is 80%, so a little way to go yet.
- The percentage of pupils who have achieved between 90% and 96% is 29%.

In order for your child to continue to receive the best education that they can, we ask that children still come to school with minor illnesses, such as coughs and colds. We will contact you if we have any concerns and if they need to be collected.
