Changes to after School Provision

Dear Parents and Carers,

We understand how important flexible and affordable after school care is to you at Morton Primary Academy. With this in mind, we are doing everything that we can to ensure that we can continue to offer this service in a planned and organised way at an affordable and economically viable rate. However as, our provision is currently running at a financial loss, we have undertaken a review and have had to make some changes to our offer.

From week commencing 17th April (After the Easter holidays)

Food & Refreshments: From 17th April 2023, we will only be able to provide a cold snack each evening for the children. This will consist of items such as cheese and crackers, fruit or a cereal bar. Cold drinks will also be provided. For those parents wishing their children to have a more substantial meal, please provide children with a packed meal from home. Unfortunately, due to strict hygiene and food standards regulations, we are no longer able to provide hot meals or drinks.

From week commencing 1st May 2023:

Costs of Provision: Starting from 1st May 2023 we will be introducing three specific time slots meaning that costs to you will be proportionate to the amount of time your child/children are in after school provision. Children remaining in school at the end of the school day will be charged:

- Until 4.00: £2.50 per child
- Until 5.00: £5.00 per child
- Until 5.45: £7.50 per child

New booking system: From 1st May 2023, places for after school club will need to be booked at least 24 hours in advance. We only have space and staffing for 30 children each evening so places will be strictly limited on a first come, first served basis. In order to ensure your child's / children's place, you will need book via the school reception where there will be a booking form. If you are unable to come into school, you will need to book via telephone at the school office.

Home/school agreement: From 1st May 2023, parents will be required to sign a home/school agreement to agree terms and conditions in order for their child/children to attend our after school provision. This is to ensure the smooth running of the provision and offers transparency and clarity for all parties involved so.
