Dear Parent / Carer

The Enrichment Week that is to be held during the week of 8 July to 12 July is approaching quickly. A few months ago, you completed our online form selecting 'Option C' for your child for this week. This was advertised at a cost of £60.00. The planned trips and transport for Option C have now been finalised, and we have booked the following trips and activities for your child to take place during Enrichment Week. This package has been subsidised considerably by the school.

Monday – pupils will be in school for a variety of enrichment activities (usual school times).

Tuesday – theatre trip to Manchester Opera House to watch the production of 'Juliet'. As this is an evening performance pupils will not be in school during the usual school day but need to arrive at school at 3.30pm and they will return to school at approximately 11.30pm.

Wednesday – trip to the Etihad Football Stadium in Manchester (arrive in school by 10.15am and return to school at approximately 4.00pm).

Thursday – pupils will be in school with follow up activities to the trips so far in the week (usual school times)

Friday – Smithills Farm trip where pupils must be in school by 8.30am and will return to school at about 3.00pm.

We are asking that payment is made through ScoPay by **Friday 28 June** to secure a place on Option C. If payment is not made by this time, we will transfer your child to Option A, details of which can be found on the school website.

Further information

Uniform

Uniform is not required to be worn when pupils are out on any of the school trips, however, when in school we ask that they wear their PE kit or other appropriate sportswear.

Food

If your child is entitled to a free school meal, they will receive this as usual on the days they are in school. Where children entitled to a free meal are out on a trip for the day, we will provide a packed lunch for them to take on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

For the theatre trip on Tuesday, there will be a cold meal available to purchase from the school canteen before pupils depart for the theatre. Pupils entitled to a free meal will receive this for free, any other pupils can purchase food to eat before departing.

Spending money

There will be an opportunity to purchase food and souvenirs at many of the venues and therefore pupils can take money if they wish. We recommend this is only a small amount. However, the Manchester Opera House is a card-only venue and so taking cash will not be necessary.

Clothing

We ask that when pupils are out on school trips, they dress appropriately. By this we discourage crop tops and skirts shorter than their usual uniform skirt. We would also ask that they take suncream if the weather is nice, and a raincoat if the weather deems this more appropriate.

Attendance

Just a reminder that during the week, usual attendance procedures should be followed. Pupils absent without good reason will be coded as unauthorised.

Mobile phones

Pupils who are going out of school on a school trip will be allowed to take these with them as we may encourage pupils to contact parents to inform them of a more precise arrival time back to school. Pupils will be reminded of the appropriate use of mobile phones when they are out on the trips. Pupils in school will not be permitted to use their phones during school hours as usual.
