Clegg Bamber MBE



Former Mount Carmel pupil, Clegg, was honoured with an MBE in the 2021 Queen's birthday honours list for his services to education. Clegg was recognised for his work with Anna Miles founding the Red Box Project which provided free period products to schools.

Clegg and Anna started the Red Box Project when Clegg was in his final year at university after discovering that period poverty wasn't just an issue in lower to middle income nations but that it was also experienced by as many as 1 in 10 young people in the UK.

The pair decided that action needed to be taken, and with the support of over 600 volunteers, the Red Box Project supported more than 5,800 schools and colleges across the UK with access to free period products. The project has expanded globally and supports young people in Moldova, Poland, US, Ireland, Hong Kong, Japan, India, and the Isle of Man. The project also inspired a community scheme in Tanzania.

In 2019 the charity launched a legal campaign against the Government which resulted in securing a policy change. The new policy meant that from January 2020 all schools and colleges had access to free period products, paid for by the Department for Education.

Clegg currently works as a Senior External Affairs manager for a government agency who direct funding for research and innovation. He is the Director of the Free Periods campaign and co-founder of the Red Box Project.
