RSB BIOLOGY CHALLENGE 2026

The Biology Challenge is an international competition. It stimulates curiosity for the natural world and encourages pupils to take an interest in Biology above and beyond what is covered in the classroom.

Over 42,000 pupils from more than 600 schools worldwide competed this year in May. Only the top 15 % of competitors were awarded a medal and had to achieve over 81% in the competition.
