Dear Parent/Carer

As you will no doubt be aware by now, the Hyndburn secondary Headteachers have collectively decided that face to face transition visits for Year 6 pupils moving to secondary school, should be delayed this year until September (see enclosed letter).

We do however recognise that the Year 6 pupils (and parents too!) will be anxious about their move to secondary school, so the purpose of this letter is to outline the arrangements we are putting in place to make this transition as smooth as possible.

Almost all primary schools have now been visited and pupils will be starting to recognise the lovely faces of Miss Aldis (Pastoral Leader of Year 7), Mrs Green (Assistant Pastoral Leader of Year 7) and Mrs Lowe (Transition Leader), and over the coming weeks Year 7 form tutors will be telephoning Year 6 pupils to introduce themselves. Summer School

We are offering a summer school in August to ensure new pupils have the opportunity to visit and experience Mount Carmel before they start in September. There will be 2 days on offer at school and these will have a focus on 'Family, Faith and Learning'. The start of the new term in September will cover all the activities that were planned for the July 'Next Steps' days that were unfortunately cancelled in order to ensure that the pupils still have their transition days.
