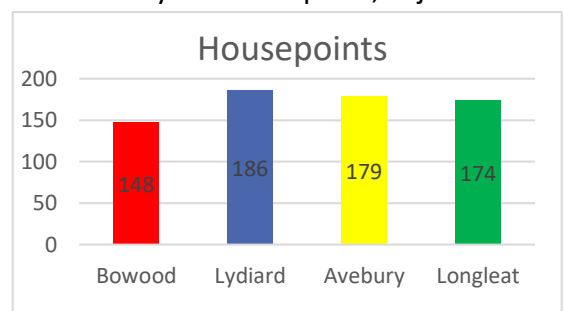

UNIFORM REMINDERS

Forest School days
