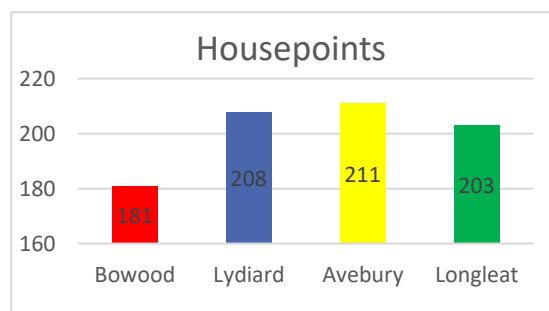
The children are still showing us their super abilities in their learning skills and behaviour with their fabulous values and these children were celebrated this week for achieving the certificate of excellence or the values award:
