Provider Access Policy

Introduction

This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purposes of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Student entitlement

Students in years 8-13 are entitled:

- To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point and whether these courses would be suitable for individual pupils and fully meet their needs.
- To have the opportunity to hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships- this information, if provided by local providers, can be disseminated, where appropriate at Annual Review Meetings
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses where appropriate and applicable
