

## PRIMARY SPORT FUNDING 13/14

This grant was used to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport, for the benefit of pupils aged 5-11, so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles.

Schools are required to publish, on their website, information about the use of this grant.

Mountjoy School received £2,457 for 13/14 financial year.

PE equipment	£426.00	The purchasing of specific equipment to enrich PE lessons taught in school. This has had a greater impact on physical development especially in gross motor skills.
Circus Skills Workshops	£425.00	All pupils accessed this at an individual level. The main aims for this session were participation in group physical activities; sharing new skills learnt and showcasing learnt skills to an audience. All objectives were met and the pupils' evaluations clearly demonstrated that they thoroughly enjoyed the event, highlighting that they had enjoyed learning new physical skills and that the event had been fun. There was an emphasis throughout the day on hand-eye coordination and working together as a team to carry out a physical skill.
Action Van	£288.00	All pupils accessed a variety of physical and competitive activities including: Tennis, Volleyball, Benchball, Netball and dance. Specialist coaches worked with small groups of pupils to teach new skills and games.
Life Education Van	£670.00	All pupils accessed the Life Education Bus – learning about how to look after their bodies and how to adopt a healthy lifestyle. The impact has been an increased understanding of how to keep themselves healthy and how different things affect their bodies.
Swimming	£348.00	Pupils have accessed the Beaminster Community Pool for swimming lessons. There has been an increase in pupils' water confidence in the swimming pool along with progress made in swimming.
Inter-school Sports Competitions including: Boccia event Beach Festival Challenge Day Dance Festival Cricket Festival Football event	£300.00	Different groups of pupils have accessed the different activities throughout the year. These events have given opportunities for pupils to work together in teams and experience playing competitive sports with teams from other schools. For some festivals, pupils have worked within mixed teams from different schools.
