

SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE

Our sixth form are student leaders in the school community. Their dress and appearance must therefore be appropriate to support and encourage the ethos of the school and the uniform and appearance policies in operation in Years 7 to 11.

We do not expect you to wear a uniform for school, but we do expect you to follow this dress code as you are ambassadors for the Academy, and you set the standards which aspiring learners in lower year groups will follow.

Sixth form students are required to always wear their ID badge when in the Academy.

Item	Not Appropriate
Trousers/Shorts	Ripped jeans Ripped shorts Beach/swim shorts Leggings
Skirts/Dresses	Clothing more than 5cm above the knee
Tights	Fishnet tights Over the knee/knee high socks Stockings
Tops	Strapless tops Vest tops Off the shoulder tops Low cut tops Crop tops
Footwear	Shoes with heels higher than 5cm Flip flops Strappy sandals Backless shoes
Hairstyles	No extreme hair styles/colour
Body Art	Visible tattoos
Body Piercings	Obvious piercings such as nose, eyebrow, tongue, and other body piercings can be a health & safety hazard and are therefore not acceptable

Health & safety requirements may dictate that there are specific subject regulations as regards jewellery, false nails etc.

If the dress code has been breached, we will follow the appropriate routes:

- The sixth form team are responsible for the monitoring of the dress code, they will highlight this to students in the first instance and inform parents if this continues.
- Students may be asked to go home and change if there is no improvement.

The Head of Sixth Form reserves the right to ask students who persistently do not adhere to the dress code, to leave the Academy.
