Dear Parents/Carers,

With the Transition days for your children fast approaching, I would like to pass on some relevant information that will help you with planning for those days.

The timings of Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> July and Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July are 8.45am-3pm, with the meet the Tutor evening on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July 5.30pm-7pm. All school transport busses will be running on the day and further information in school transport can be found on the Cambridgeshire County Council website [School transport | Cambridgeshire County Council](#).

When your children arrive, we would like them to make their way to the Main Hall through the side entrance (see map). There will be plenty of staff directing you in the right direction. They will then need to register in the hall, alphabetically by surname. From there they will be placed into their tutor groups and given their timetables for the day.

During the day, they will move from lesson to lesson but will be escorted by current Year 7 students and Year 10 students so they don't get lost! We know this is a very real concern for our new students. They will have two 30 minute breaks during the day and a 30 minute lunch. They will need to bring a snack and a drink, but we will provide lunch both days. This is so the students understand how the canteen works before they come to us in September and so that they can taste the great food on offer.

They will be taking part in a number of exciting lessons over the two days including Science, Art, English and PE.



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They will have workbooks that they will complete their work in and bring home to show you. I have designed these so that they have a map in the book as well as the school routines for behaviour. Please take some time over the summer holidays to discuss these and in turn, hopefully alleviate any concerns they may have.

When the day ends at 3pm, please could you pick your children up from the Main Hall side entrance where you dropped them off in the morning. They will be signed out by a staff member. Please could you fill in the Microsoft form so we know how your child is travelling to and from Neale-Wade Academy during the transition days.
