English: Diary of Anne Frank, Bedrock & SPaG

This half-term, your English tasks will be a mixture of Bedrock Vocabulary, SPaG on Doodle and reading a new novel 'The Diary of Anne Frank'. You will receive a copy of this book to keep to your home address in the post.

All reading and writing activities for 'The Diary of Anne Frank' are on a specially made online 'Padlet' – click here to access it: <https://padlet.com/ProsperEnglish/h7cqslsbs0vi7oh8> or scan this QR code:



You do not need a personal account for this; you can access it on your smartphone/device/ computer at home that has access to the Internet. If you don't have access to the Internet at home, contact school for a paper copy of activities.

The 'Creative Projects', 'Further Reading' and 'The Diary of Anne Frank' are challenging, *optional* tasks to make you think harder about your reading. There is no expectation for these to be completed, but are there to stretch and challenge you.

You should be reading for 30 minutes every morning as part of your Home Learning timetable. We would advise you to use some of these morning slots to read 'The Diary of Anne Frank' so that you manage to keep up with the reading each week. You could alternate each morning: one morning reading First News and the next The Diary of Anne Frank and so on.

Want to have a go at a CREATIVE PROJECT? Have a go at the following...

- ✓ Read another book, possibly 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas' and write an account of what you learn about concentration camps. How is the perspective different?
- ✓ Research survivors' stories on the internet. Create a PowerPoint presentation which shows the survivors and gives information about what happened to them.
- ✓ Research the concentration camp Auschwitz, where Anne Frank was taken after capture. Create a fact sheet about it.
- ✓ Start writing your own diary and try and complete a section each day. Write about what your hopes are and what you hope to have achieved by then. What aspects of life do you hope have improved?
- ✓ Research The Holocaust in more detail. Which countries in Europe were most affected by it? Imagine you were one of the people being transported to the internment camps. Write a poem explaining what happened.
- ✓ Design your own alternative book cover for The Diary of Anne Frank or a book cover for the diary you are writing.
- ✓ Create a quiz about the diary that you could share with a friend or teacher.
- ✓ Turn your book review into a video, where you film yourself reviewing the book.

Want a further challenge?

- ✓ Join in with the online book club by responding to the questions with your own comments.


