Problem Solving Lesson: Finding the Difference

To be written in books:

How old are you?

Roll a dice. Can you find the difference between the number you rolled and your own age? Do this 5 times.

You can use cubes or a number line to help you.

Repeat using somebody else's age.

More Difficult:

Solve the clues to find out the children's ages.

How old is Jian?

What age is four years more than five years old?

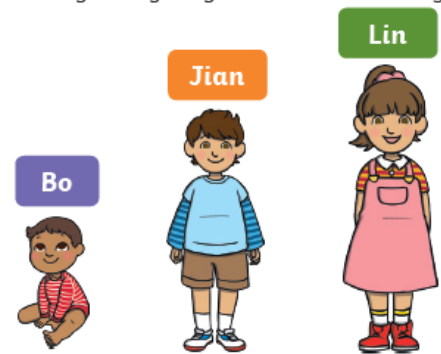
You can use a number line or cubes to find out.

Who is older - Jian or Lin?

If you know Lin's age, how can you work out Bo's age?

Explain your method.

Three siblings are giving clues about their ages.



Jian is 5.

Lin's age is 4 years more than Jian's.

The difference between the oldest and youngest is 7 years.

How old are Bo and Lin?

Use cubes to make towers that represent their ages.

Roll a dice and find the difference between the number and your age. Do this five times.

Dictated sentence:

Please read the sentence to your child. Then re-read slowly one word at a time while your child writes the sentence.

Healthy Me	<p>The theme for our Jigsaw PSHE work this term is ‘Relationships’.</p> <p>Start by doing your Jigsaw Jack calm breathing. Try to ask someone in your family to join in. Think about what makes a good friend. Write a list of your ideas.</p>
Problem of the day	<p>Challenge – Can you make a rainbow to celebrate our NHS? Use Lego, blocks, recycling objects (make sure you check with an adult if they are clean and safe to use) to create your rainbow.</p> <p>Riddle of the day – What question can someone ask all day long, always get completely different answers, and yet all the answers could be correct?</p>
