Because they get to teach and spend the time next year with you.

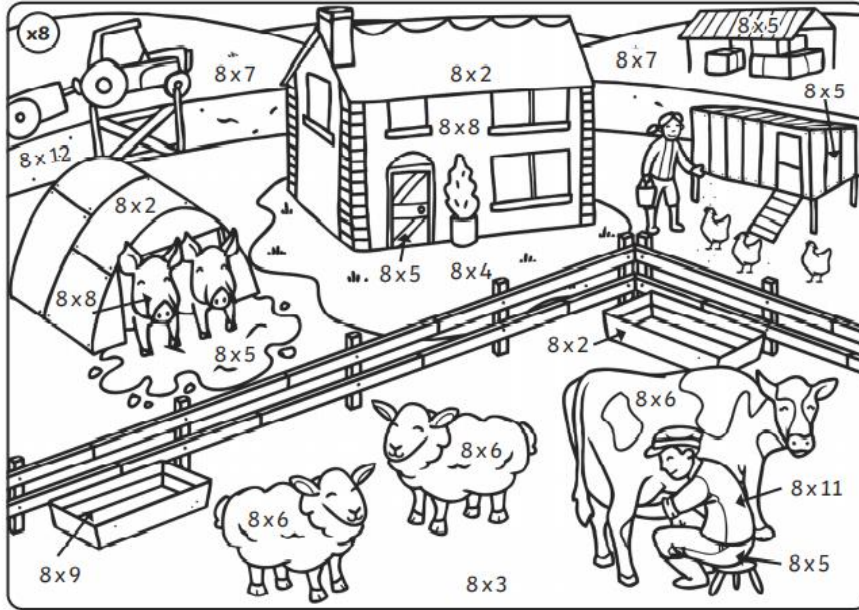


Keep reading over the summer holidays. If you don't do any other learning, reading will make such a difference! The libraries are doing an online reading challenge over the summer so why not get involved?

Fun Maths and Science Challenge

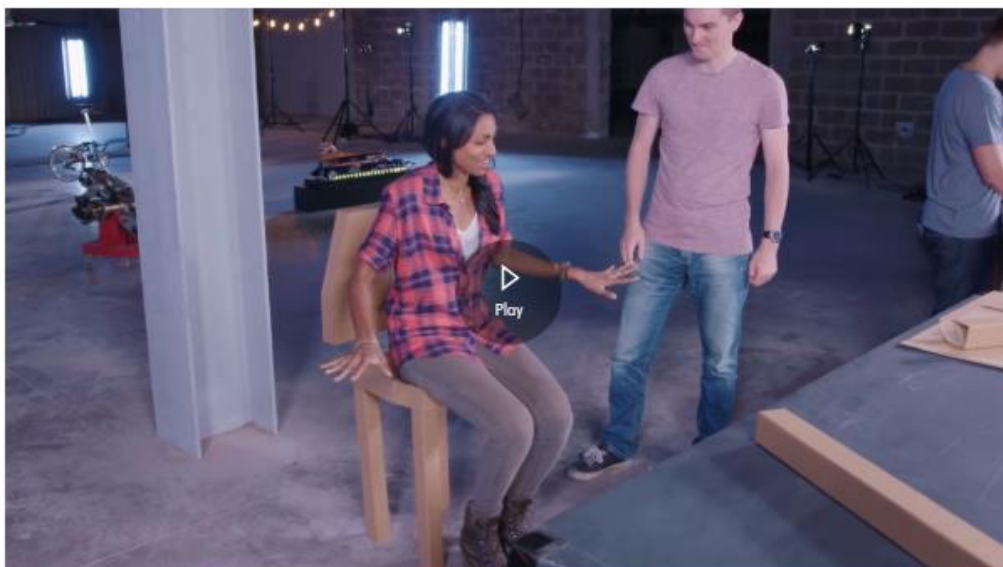
Today, we are going to look at challenge from the James Dyson website:

- What adventures are they going on?



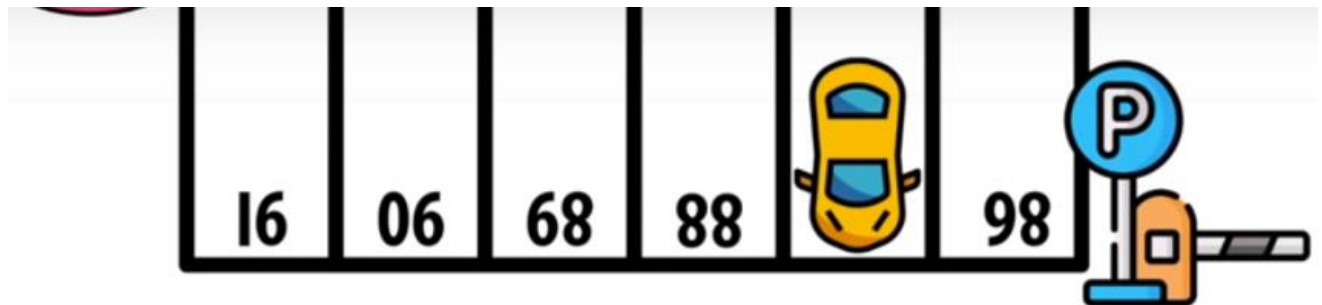
