Get someone to test you on a times table. To make it more difficult, make them test you using flash cards. They could test you on all your times tables or decimal times tables (e.g.  $0.6 \times 5 = 3$ ).

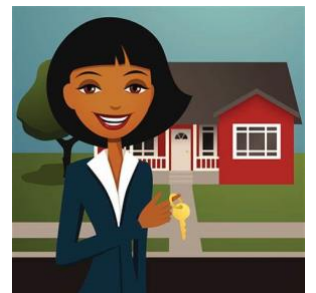
**Daily English**
