Daily reading	Today please read a book of your choice for 10 minutes then spend 5 minutes retelling what you have read and answering questions about it. Please ask an adult to help you with this. If anyone at home has the opportunity to discuss this with you, please ask them to.
Daily counting, number bonds or times tables	Can you count forwards and backwards from 0 - 50 or 0 – 100? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OTgLtF3PMOc Extension: Count forwards and backwards through 100.
Termly Spellings	Please take time to learn spellings for future weeks and to re-visit past spellings. These can be found on the school website at https://www.newbridge.bathnes.sch.uk/ and go to the tab Classes and click on your class.
Daily Maths	Set up a sweet/ toy shop with prices ranging between 1p-£1. Model choosing 2 items and adding up the total drawing pictorially. Record the number sentence on a whiteboard. Now try it with 3 items. Extension - I spent 48p. Which 2 toys/sweets did I buy? How many possibilities are there?
Daily English/ Phonics	Dictated sentence: Please read the sentence to your child. Then re-read slowly one word at a time while your child writes the sentence. <i>If I watch too much television will my eyes go square?</i> Extension – Write 2 more sentences which use the other spelling of the homophone ‘too’: to and two. Copy the following real and alien words, then put sound buttons on them. Press the buttons to read the words. beehive river thrant plap Put the following common exception words into sentences.
