Bethan had great fun painting with natural colours and wanted to share a pic. She used mud, grass and beetroot stems!

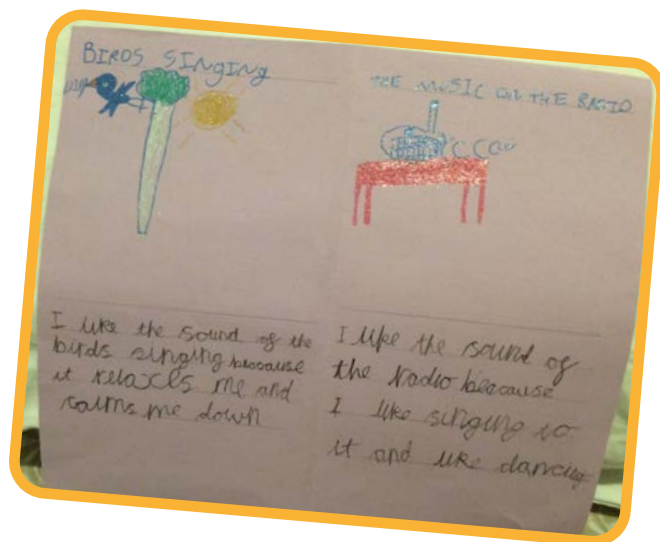
A spot of outdoor artwork today in the garden, Ella loved the new tent we brought online and is using it as an art den.

Here is a picture of the 'sounds' that Isla likes, for Feel Good Friday.



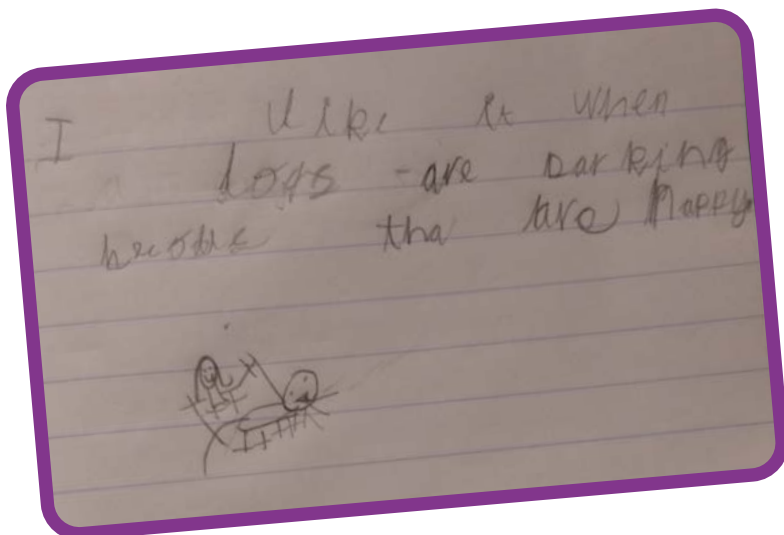
Happy Feel Good Friday from Lara 2G

Millie built a fire in our living room with her brother Joe (who will be joining Reception in september) and enjoyed 'toasting' marshmallows.

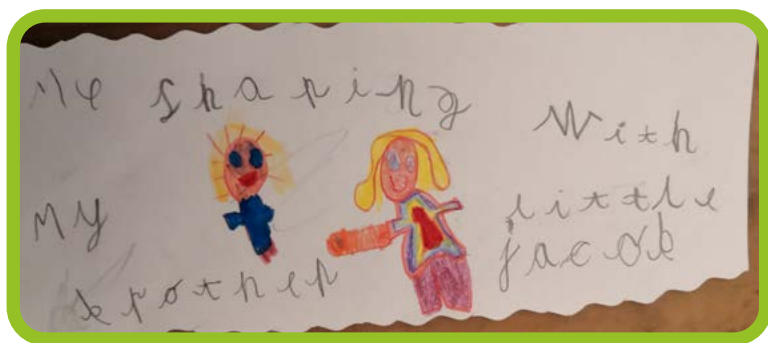
