**Daily Maths**

To be written in books:  
**Problem Solving Activity:** Length  
**You will need:** a can of food e.g. baked beans.

It's time to go on a height hunt!  
 Put the can of baked beans in the middle of the table.

Find 2 objects shorter than the can and 2 objects taller than the can.  
 You should now have a line of 5 objects.

Practise saying the sentences out loud and then copy them into your books.

The \_\_\_\_\_ is the tallest.  
 The \_\_\_\_\_ is the shortest.  
 The \_\_\_\_\_ is taller than the \_\_\_\_\_.  
 The \_\_\_\_\_ is shorter than the \_\_\_\_\_.

**More difficult:** - find an object that is exactly the same height as a can of baked beans.

**Challenge** – What is the tallest thing you can see today?  
 Maybe you can look outside when you go for a walk.

<b>Daily English/ Phonics</b>	<p><b>Writing:</b> Our new enquiry is all about differences. Can you think of pairs of objects that are similar but different? Now put your ideas in to sentences.</p> <p>For example, a dog is different to a cat because you take it for walks. An orange is different to an apple because it has pips. Remember to include a capital letter, finger spaces and full stop for each sentence.</p> <p><b>Dictated sentence:</b> Please read the sentence to your child. Then re-read slowly one word at a time while your child writes the sentence.</p> <p><i>Stan went to grill fresh meat.</i></p> <p>Extension – Can you extend your sentence using <b>and/because/when</b>?</p> <p>Copy the following real and alien words, then put sound buttons on them. Press the buttons to read the words.</p> <p><b>sut shop vaw few</b></p> <p>Play Quick Write.
