Daily counting, number bonds or times tables	Estimating and counting in 5s. Take a handful of objects e.g. bricks, sticks or cereal. <b>Guess</b> how many you have altogether. Put them into groups of 5. Count in 5s. How many do you have altogether?
Termly Spellings	Please take time to learn spellings for future weeks and to re-visit past spellings. These can be found on the school website at <u>https://www.newbridge.bathnes.sch.uk/</u> and go to the tab <b>Classes</b> and click on your class. You might like to try this method of learning words forces you to think of each letter separately. p py pyr pyra pyra m pyra m i pyra m id
Daily Maths	<ul> <li>Position and direction.</li> <li>Practise using directions 'left' and 'right'</li> <li>Wave your left hand. Hop on your right foot etc. You could play a game of Twister if you have it!</li> <li>Give the children instructions using the language 'quarter turn', 'half turn', 'three quarters turn' and 'full turn'.</li> <li>Take turns to give and follow directions E.g. Turn one quarter to the right.</li> <li>This could be developed into a dance routine with music.</li> <li>Children should investigate whether they can finish facing the same direction if they complete different turns. So, 4 x quarter turns is the same as one full turn or 2 half turns.</li> <li>Option: You could also try 'l-spy'. I can see something a quarter of a turn to my right beginning with T.</li> </ul>
Daily English/ Phonics	<ul> <li>Writing:</li> <li>In our writing today, we are thinking about likes and dislikes. These are different as they are opposites. Talk to someone in your family about things you like and why you like them. Now talk about things you dislike and why.</li> <li>Now we are going to write about our likes and dislikes using the conjunction but. For example – I like to eat strawberries but I don't like eating bananas.</li> <li>To challenge yourself you could include reasons why. For example - I like to eat strawberries because they are delicious but I don't like eating bananas because they are slimy.</li> <li>Remember to include a capital letter, finger spaces and full stop for each sentence, and remember that special word but too.</li> </ul>
