Daily reading	<p>Today, please read a book of your choice for 10 minutes then spend 5 minutes retelling what you have read and answering questions about it. Please ask an adult to help you with this.</p> <p>Thinking about the book you are reading at the moment. Do you like the story? Daily counting, number bonds or times tables	<p>Practise your number bonds to 20. Ask Quick fire questions, adding and subtracting numbers under 20. e.g. 12 - 6 or 11 + 4</p> <p>Or join in with the Jack Hartmann video Number bonds 11-19. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=MmLMU8BgyKw</p>
Termly Spellings	<p>Please take time to learn spellings for future weeks and to re-visit past spellings. These can be found on the school website at https://www.newbridge.bathnes.sch.uk/ and go to the tab Classes and click on your class. Daily Maths	<p>Lesson 1: To be written in books or practical. Multiplication: Problem Solving Activity You will need: teddies (or toys) and coins (you can make the coins out of paper or cut them out of the sheet at the bottom of today's daily learning sheet).</p> <p>Line up 5 teddies (or toys). Give each teddy two 5p coins. How many coins are there altogether?</p> <p>Say out loud or copy and complete the sentences into your books. There are ___ 5p coins in each group. There are ___ coins all together. Show your working out $2 + 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 =$</p> <p>Challenge - How much money does each teddy have? $5p + 5p =$ How much money is there altogether?</p>

	<p>Line up 3 teddies. Give each teddy ten 2p coins. How many coins are there altogether?</p> <p>Say out loud or copy and complete the sentences into your books. <i>There are __ 2p coins in each group.</i> <i>There are __ coins altogether.</i> How did you work it out? $10 + 10 + 10 =$</p> <p>Challenge - How much money does each teddy have? $2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p$</p> <p>Line up 4 teddies. Give each teddy five 10p coins. How many coins are there altogether?</p> <p>Say out loud or copy and complete the sentences into your books. <i>There are __ 10p coins in each group.</i> <i>There are __ coins altogether.</i></p> <p>How did you work it out? $5 + 5 + 5 + 5 =$</p> <p>Challenge - How much money does each teddy have?</p>
Daily English/Phonics	<p>Writing: With a grown up look back at the weather diary you wrote last week. Discuss the weather. What happened? Was it the same or different? Now write some sentences in your book describing the weather last week. Remember to include a capital letter, finger spaces and full stop for each sentence, think about including adjectives too. Also, if you use names of the days, they will need a capital letter too.</p> <p>Dictated sentence: Please read the sentence to your child. Then re-read it slowly one word at a time while your child writes the sentence.</p> <p><i>Fran sent a snail as a present for her dad.</i></p> <p>Extension – Can you extend your sentence using and/because/when?</p> <p>Copy the following real and alien words, then put sound buttons on them. Press the buttons to read the words.</p> <p>shig sweep throst trails</p> <p>Play Quick Write. How many times can you write each word in a minute?</p> <p>my here there</p> <p>Optional game –Forest Phonics https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/forestPhonics/index.html Or feel free to pick another game from the website.</p>
Healthy Me	<p>Cosmic Kids Yoga – Nelson the Pigeon https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kN1_qchKPnA</p> <p>Can you watch or do something funny and enjoy how it feels to laugh?</p>
Problem of the day	<p>Challenge – Can you design a picture frame for one of your favourite pictures? Use Lego, blocks, recycling objects (make sure you check with an adult if they are clean and safe to use) to build your picture frame.</p> <p>Riddle of the day – What can you keep after giving to someone?</p>
