Solve the double problems to make your rocket and get all the parts ready to set off.

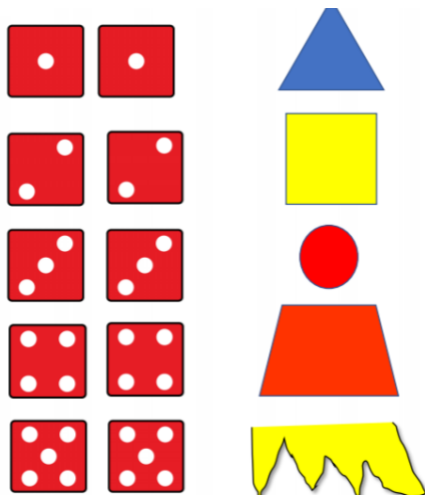
You will need 2 dice.
