Daily reading

Today, please read a book of your choice for 10 minutes then spend 5 minutes retelling what you have read and answering questions about it. Please ask an adult to help you with this.

Can you tell someone what happened at the start, the middle and the end of the book you are reading?

Daily counting, number bonds or times tables

This week, we will focus on knowing number bonds to 10 (or any number up to 20) without using resources to work them out. Children should be able to recall the answers quickly.

Number bonds that equal 10.

Child starts by writing 10 – in their books.

Make a pile of number cards from Monday (0-10).

Child takes the first card and writes it in their number sentence. E.g. 10 -1 =

Keep going until all of the cards have been used.

Remember the focus is on knowing the answer and not challenging them to work it out.

Termly Spellings

Please take time to learn spellings for future weeks and to re-visit past spellings.

You could try it this way today.

Write the word out on a sheet of paper, ensuring that it is spelt correctly and it is large enough to trace over. Trace over the word and say it at the same time. Move next to the word you have just written and write it out as you say it. Turn the page over and write the word as you say it, and then check that you have spelt it correctly.

Daily Maths

Play robots

Start by hiding 3 toys around the room.


Agree a start point.

The leader gives instructions to the robot so that they can find the toys.

e.g. forward 3 steps, turn left, forward 2 steps Take turns on being the robot and the leader.

Copy the grid on the activity card (a bigger copy is at the bottom of today's learning).

Follow the instructions and draw the objects on the grid.



Daily English/	Writing:
Phonics	Just like yesterday, we are going to think about comparing the differences between the weather in different seasons. Today, we are going to compare the weather in Winter and Summer. Look back at the writing you did for each of those seasons first, as this will help you today. Now you are ready to write some sentences. We'd like you to try to join some sentences using the word but. For example, In Winter it can snow but in Summer it does not. Remember to include a capital letter, finger spaces and full stop for each sentence, think about including adjectives too. Also, if you use the name of the season, remember it will need a capital letter.
	Dictated sentence: Please read the sentence to your child. Then re-read slowly one word at a time while your child writes the sentence.
	We must not jump on flowers.
	Extension – Can you extend your sentence using and/because/when?
	Copy the following real and alien words, then put sound buttons on them. Press the buttons to read the words.
