


Newbridge Primary School Year 1 Daily Learning

Daily reading	Today, please read a book of your choice for 10 minutes then spend 5 minutes retelling what you have read and answering questions about it. Please ask an adult to help you with this.	
	In the book you are reading at the moment, who is your favourite character? Can you explain why?

Daily counting, number bonds or	Counting objects in 2s	
times tables	Cut up a piece of fruit into bite size pieces or grab a handful of cereal. Guess how many pieces there are.	
	Check if you were right by counting the pieces in 2s. Finally enjoy your snack!

Daily Maths	Lesson 4: To be written in books	
	Problem Solving Activity: Weight	
	You will need: scales, ingredients, recipes.	
	Making or baking challenge:	
	Look at a recipe and find the weight of the different ingredients.	
	What is the heaviest ingredient?	
	What is the lightest ingredient?	
	Work together to make or bake*. This could be a bake e.g. fairy cakes or cookies or a make e.g. pasta pesto or beans on toast. The important part is children seeing and experiencing how we use weight in everyday life. While we don't usually weigh bread to make toast it will be interesting for the children to see how heavy it is.	
	Challenge : A can of baked beans weighs 400g. If a family of 4 share one can, how many grams will each person have? How many cans would a family of 6 need?	
	*If you do not have weighing scales at home, please copy the ingredients for a recipe in your maths book. Talk to your grown about the different weights and answer the questions above.	

Daily English/ Phonics

Writing:

Today, we are going to write a mini beast fact file. You can use all the information you have learned about our enquiry and our work on adjectives, to help you. Here is an example of how to set out your work and the sort of headings to use. You will need an adult to help you with this part.



Now, pick a mini beast to write about and complete each section. You might need to do some research. If so, ask an adult to help you, especially if you use the internet. Remember to stay safe online. Also remember to include a capital letter, finger spaces and full stop for each sentence. You'll need to include adjectives too. For a challenge, can you use 'and' to extend at least one of your sentences?

Now share your writing with someone in your family. Were they impressed with your knowledge of mini beasts?

Dictated sentence:

Please read the sentence to your child. Then re-read slowly one word at a time while your child writes the sentence.

We might fly to the moon in a plane.

Extension – Can you extend your sentence using and/because/when?

Use rainbow writing to practise spelling these common exception words. Try to spend about a minute on each word. You can either do it like this **some**, changing the colour of each letter or like this **some some some**, changing the colour each time you write the word.
