<b>Daily reading</b>	<p>Today, please read a book of your choice for 10 minutes. Can you predict what might happen in the story based on what has been read so far?</p> <p><b>Top Tips:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Make sure you are reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction books. Can you identify how non-fiction texts are structured in different ways? e.g. contents page, subheadings.</li> <li>· Discuss and clarify the meanings of any new words – could you have a pencil with you and note any words that you are unfamiliar with throughout the story?</li> <li>· Could you ring or FaceTime a family member and let them hear you read for 5 minutes?</li> </ul>
<b>Daily counting, number bonds or times tables</b>	<p><b>Multiplication bingo:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Draw a 3x3 grid on a piece of paper and write numbers from a times table that you are learning.</li> <li>2. Adult or sibling to call out times table questions.</li> <li>3. Children to work out the answer and cross it off their grid if it is there.</li> <li>4. The aim is to have all numbers crossed out to achieve bingo.</li> </ol>
