Daily times tables	<p>How have you been getting on with learning your tables? We hope you are becoming more confident with them.</p> <p>This week, we would like you to concentrate on the times table you are least confident with. It could be 6x, 7x, 8x, 9x or your 12x or even your 13x In order to know them really well, you must focus on the same time table for the week. There are different ways to learn them:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write them out in order e.g. $1 \times 9 = 9$, $2 \times 9 = 18$. Then you could write them out in reverse starting with $12 \times 9 = 108$ • You could find patterns in the times table and highlight them; e.g. does anything happen to the ten or ones digit? • Could you make up a rhyme? <p><i>Five times one is five Maybe we should drive to the hive</i></p> <p><i>I 8 and I 8 and I fell on the floor. I couldn't get up until I was 64.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Or you can continue to use the useful websites www.timestable.co.uk and Hit the Button <p>We look forward to seeing the end result.</p>



- Once you have organised your information in your English book, you can plan the information page. You will have to decide how you will design your main heading, where each paragraph will go and where you want to add pictures.



Tutankhamun

Tutankhamun was an Egyptian pharaoh of the 18th dynasty (ruled c. 1332-1323 BC), during the period of Egyptian history known as the New Kingdom or sometimes the New Empire Period. He has, since his discovery, been colloquially referred to as King Tut.

Tutankhamun was the son of Akhenaten (formerly Amenhotep IV) and one of Akhenaten's sisters, or possibly one of his cousins. As a prince, he was known as Tutankhaten. He ascended to the throne in 1333 BC, at the age of nine or ten, taking the throne name Nebkheperure. When he became king, he married his half-sister, Ankhesenpaaten, who later changed her name to Ankhesenamun. They had two daughters, both stillborn.
