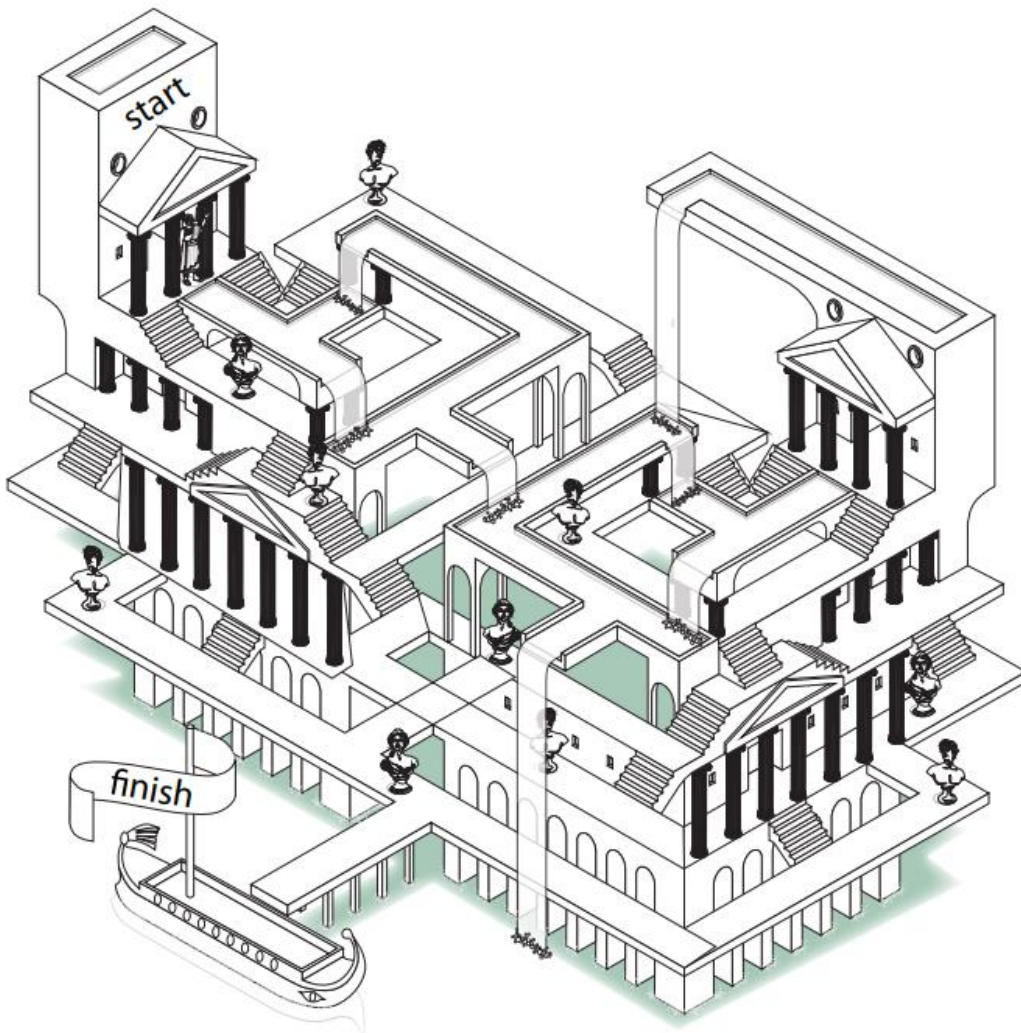
Healthy Me
