Let us know how you get on!

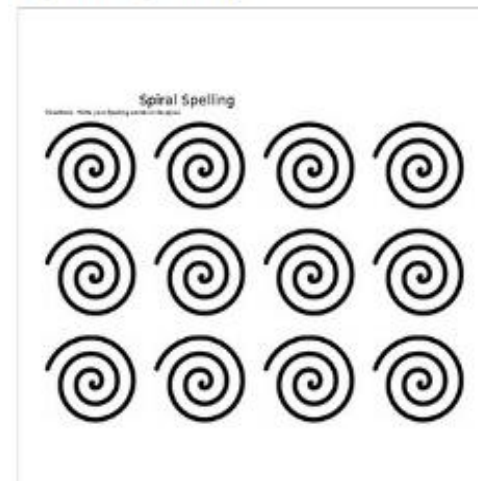
