<b>Daily reading</b>	<p>Today, please read a book of your choice for 10 minutes then spend 5 minutes retelling what you have read and answering questions about it. <b>Daily counting, number bonds or times tables</b>	<p>Make number cards with even numbers up to 20 (Easier to 10, more difficult to 30). Lay them out on the floor and walk along them, counting in 2s from 0 as you do so. Can you count backwards as well as forwards?</p>
<b>Termly Spellings</b>	<p>Please take time to learn spellings for future weeks and to re-visit past spellings. These can be found on the school website at <a href="https://www.newbridge.bathnes.sch.uk/">https://www.newbridge.bathnes.sch.uk/</a> and go to the tab <b>Classes</b> and click on your class.</p>
<b>Daily Maths</b>	<p>Today we are continuing to find equal groups.</p> <p><b>You will need:</b> The even number cards from the daily counting activity.</p> <p><b>In books:</b> Today, you are going to try and share by drawing but you can always use equipment if you need to. Choose a number card (e.g. 10) Draw 2 circles in your book. Share the number by drawing dots in the circles to make 2 equal groups. Repeat with other numbers.</p> <p><b>Problem solving:</b> What happens when the start number is odd?</p>
<b>Daily English/ Phonics</b>	<p><b>Dictated sentence:</b> Please read the sentence to your child. Then re-read slowly one word at a time while your child writes the sentence.</p> <p><i>You need to bow when you meet the queen.</i></p> <p>Extension – Can you extend your sentence using and/because/when?</p> <p>Copy the following real and alien words, then put sound buttons on them. Press the buttons to read the words. <b>skap gloom blorn twice</b></p> <p>Put the following common exception words into sentences. Remember your punctuation.</p> <p><b>ask friend school</b></p> <p>Optional game - <a href="https://www.phonicstracker.com/games/FootballPhonics/index">https://www.phonicstracker.com/games/FootballPhonics/index</a> Please pick a phase suitable for your child's ability.</p>

<b>Problem of the day</b>	<p>Challenge – They need a new hotel in Bath and the Mayor of Bath would like you to design it. Use Lego, blocks, recycling objects (make sure you check with an adult if they are clean and safe to use) to design the new hotel.</p> <p>Riddle of the day – What five letter word becomes shorter when you add two letters to it?</p>
