Today, we are turning objects.

Draw the grid below in your books and complete it.

1. Draw 4 copies of a spider.
2. Turn the spider a quarter turn at a time.
2. Stick it on the grid.

4. Repeat with a cat or a duck.

If you have an 'ink stamp' this works well instead of making 4 copies of the object E.g. the spider. Print the stamp, turn it, print it, turn etc.

<p>Healthy Me</p>	<p>Today, we are going to do our Jigsaw Jack work. The theme for our Jigsaw PSHE work this term is ‘Changing Me’.</p> <p>Start by doing your Jigsaw Jack calm breathing. Try to ask someone in your family to join in. Today, we’d like you to think about your amazing body. Talk to a grown up about what your body can do.</p> <p>In your book complete the stem sentence - <i>My body is amazing because.....</i> You might like to draw and label a picture too.</p> <p>Game changers - Think about a game you like playing and change the rules to make it different. Play it! Does it work?</p>
<p>Problem of the Day</p>	<p>Challenge – It’s your friend’s birthday. Can you design them a birthday cake? Use Lego, blocks, recycling objects (make sure you check with an adult if they are clean and safe to use) to create their cake.</p> <p>Riddle - What can you catch but not throw?</p>
