**Lesson 2 - Fact families**

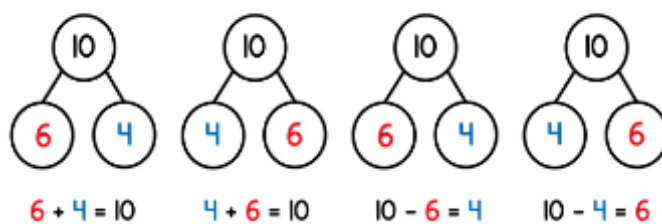
Follow the video clip. The focus is finding fact families.
