Find the value of b in these formulae if a=15

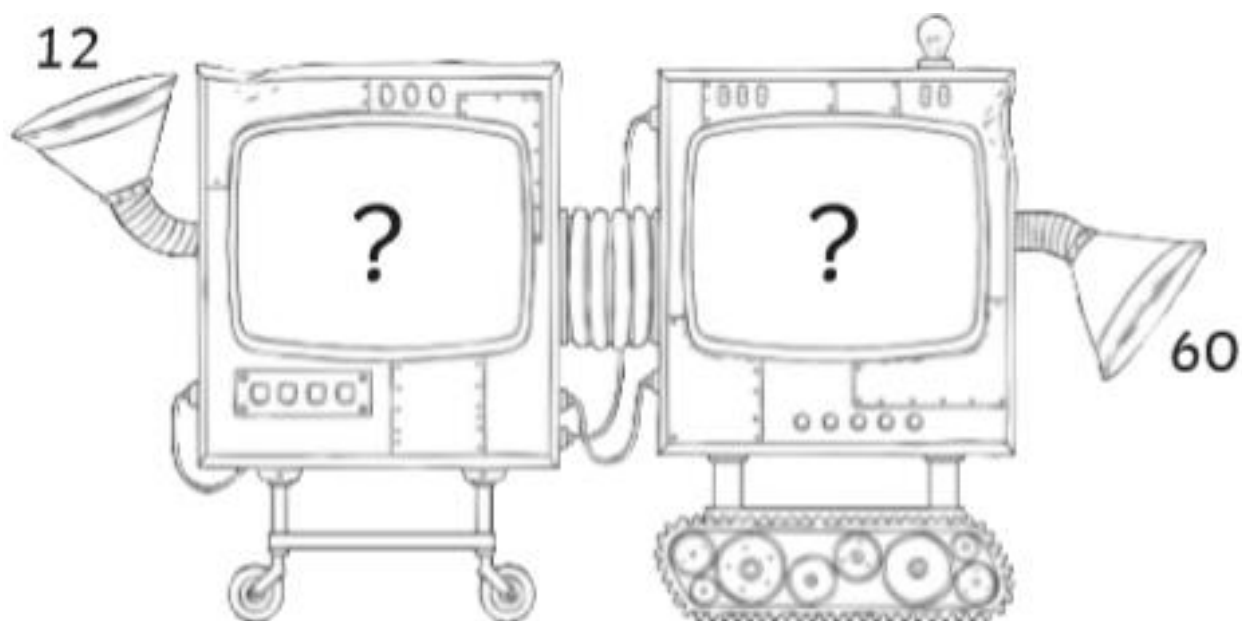

Problem of the Day

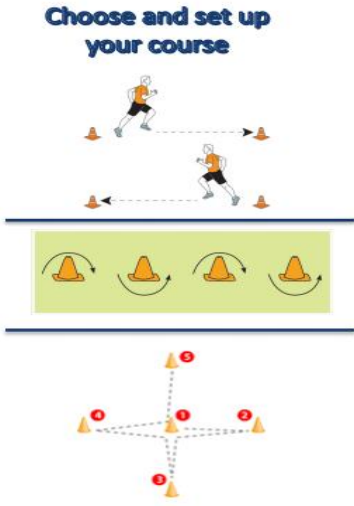
Yesterday’s problem – 40 socks.
