School Uniform Reminders

It is important that everyone upholds the school dress code. Please note reminders from this week. Children are not permitted to wear boots. Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back at all times, with no elaborate hair pieces. The only jewellery allowed is stud earings – no bracelets, rings, necklaces or hoop earrings. Nail varnish is not permitted. Uniform items should be grey and not black for trousers, shorts and pinafores. Socks should not be coloured - only black, white or grey. Skorts can be worn for PE only. Trainers can only be worn on PE days.
