As a reminder, Bag2School will accept any of the following items: re-usable clothing, paired shoes (please tie them together), bags, hats, scarves & ties, jewellery, lingerie, socks, belts, soft toys, household linen, curtains, towels, bedding (sheets, pillowcases, duvet <u>covers</u>).

They **do not accept** the following: duvets or blankets, pillows or cushions; carpets, rugs or mats; soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing; school uniform (with OR without logo); corporate clothing and workwear; textile off-cuts or yarn.

This is a great chance to get rid of all those outgrown clothes and other unwanted items. You've got two weeks! Our previous best from a single Bag2School visit was £267 - can we beat that this time?




Second-Hand Uniform Sale
