Lucy McIlroy to organise bar. Tickets to offer reduced drinks if ordered in advance. Food orders in advance. Neil to organise licence please. Reminder to bring your own (plastic) glasses. Ice pops to be sold.
 - d. Family fun run Sunday 12th June (am) Fruit and cakes. Warm up provided by personal trainers. Distance run will be tracked. Edible medals. 9.30-10.30am. MWH to send junior parkrun info to publicise. Strava segment to be created.
