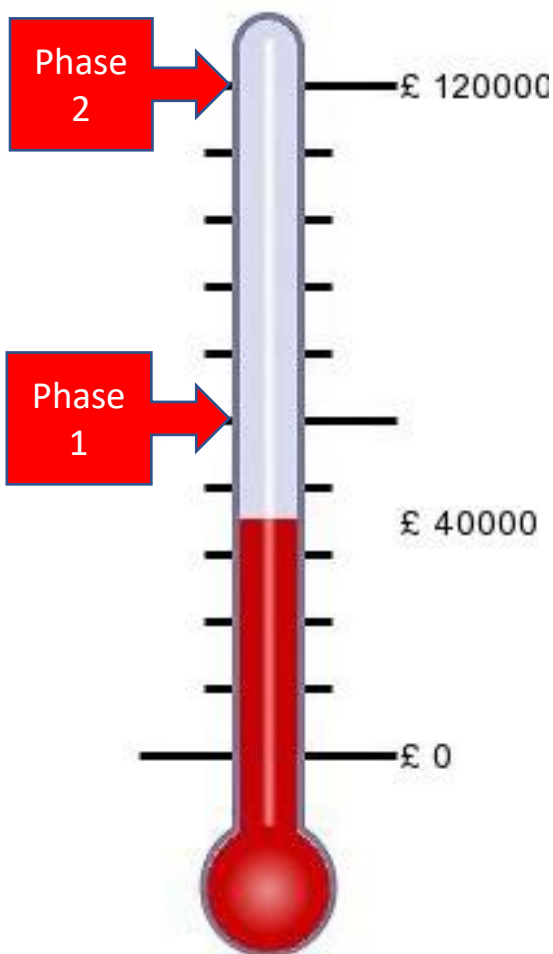

The NPSA have a vision for the school to improve play for all of our children, and for those who will attend for many years to come.

In consultation with a number of play providers we have fully costed a plan to start work early in 2023, with Phase 1 of the project which will see EYFS playground resurfaced, new equipment installed, and a full play trail fitted in Upper School (see details on the next page).

This will cost a total of £60,000 and we currently have £40,000.

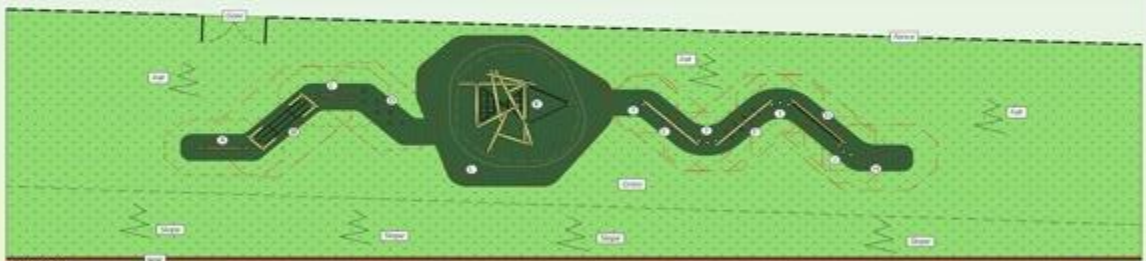
