Dear Parents and Carers

Our Reception children continue to do so well with settling into school. This week, each half of Bee and Ladybird Class, met the other half. Therefore, all of the sixty children have been in school together at times. We have been so impressed with the confidence they are demonstrating and their love for learning new things.

Today was our first 'Feel Good Friday' - on the last Friday of each month the whole school focuses on a theme, to support well-being. Today's theme was 'Facing New Challenges with Positivity'.

Extra-Curricular activities

More than ever, since 16th March 2020, school life feels pretty much normal. Another indicator of this is the recommencement of peripatetic music lessons and extra-curricular activities. Music lessons started last week and a full range of wider opportunities, through extra-curricular provision, will commence from Monday 27th September. We are able to provide twenty four clubs – before school, during lunchtime and after school - which is brilliant and such a positive step forward. Please know, that if your child is entitled to free school meals, then the school will be able to contribute towards the cost of any activities that incur a charge - please get in touch with the school office to know more about this. A document detailing where the activities will be held and the collection arrangements has been sent today. Please can I ask you to look at this, so that next week's arrangements go as smoothly as possible.

'Everyone Active'

Many families will remember that I used to provide 'Everyone Active' before the pandemic. This has been both running on the field and Street Dance in the hall. For now, this will just be the outside running sessions. For those who don't know, this is a time for all family members to come along and exercise on the field together. Everyone runs or walks laps of the field and it is not competitive, at all, just a fun and positive way to promote good health. In the past, pre-schoolers and grandparents have joined in too – the more the merrier. The children should wear PE kit and trainers and bring a filled water bottle. The grass will likely be wet on some mornings, so please be prepared for this. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 must be accompanied by an adult. For older children, who come unsupervised, they must stay on the field for the duration of the session and until I dismiss them to class at 8.40am. Please can I ask that parents leave the site at 8.40am, just before the children start to arrive for the start of school. We will keep the sessions going for as long as we can into the term, as the field may become impacted by the weather.

Parent Consultation Meetings

These will be held online, via School Cloud, on Wednesday 6th October and Tuesday 12th October between 3.45pm and 6.45pm. Each appointment, one per pupil, will be scheduled for ten minutes. The booking system opens today at 7pm, with information about this sent to you on Thursday 23rd September. When your appointment is booked, your child's learning books, from Year 1 upwards, will be sent home for the weekend either on Friday 1st or Friday 8th October. These will need to be returned to school on the following Monday.

Entitlement to Free School Meals

If you are in receipt of, or are currently applying for any of the below listed benefits, your child(ren) may be entitled to free school meals. The qualifying benefits are: Income Support; Job Seekers Allowance; Employment Support Allowance; Child Tax Credit; Pension Credit; Working Tax Credit run-on; Asylum Seeker or Universal Credit. Please know, that this application also includes those pupils currently in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 — whilst their school meals are funded by the government, as a school we can receive additional funding per child, to support their learning and wider opportunities.
