Dear Parents and Carers

I hope you have had a good week.

The number of cases of Covid-19 remains significantly lower than those known before half term, however they are increasing across the school. Therefore, unfortunately, following Public Health advice today, we will need to continue with many of the current measures. This is deeply regrettable, however, again the priority is to protect the education of all children.

There is a change to how extra-curricular activities will be able to operate. We will run the activities which take place outdoors, whether these are in single or mixed age year groups. We will also run the activities that are indoors, in single year groups. However, we are not able to operate the mixed year group clubs that are held indoors. Please see the table attached to this evening's Parentmail, providing all details of the clubs impacted and those that can operate at this time.

Breakfast Club and After School Club will continue to run, for essential use. We are only able to divide the children in After School Club by upper and lower school. In Breakfast Club, children will sit by year group, whenever possible. If parents are able to cancel any bookings that are not essential, this will be greatly appreciated and a refund will be provided.

We will unfortunately also need to postpone the Cursive Handwriting Workshop that was due to take place on Thursday 18th November.

Therefore, these measures will be in place until further notice:

- School meals and packed lunches will be served in classrooms.
- Some extra-curricular activities will be halted please see table for this detail
- Face to face meetings cannot take place. Parents should contact staff via email to the school inbox at enquiries@newbridge.bathnes.sch.uk
- Parents are requested to wear a face covering when gathering at the school gate and must wear one when entering the school site.

We are not implementing any measures which will impact on the children's education.

Please, with rising cases, can I ask all families to continue to be vigilant for symptoms of Covid-19 and to seek a PCR test when required. Also, please can parents continue with twice weekly LFD testing to identify asymptomatic cases of Covid-19.

Outdoor Learning Day




