

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Dear Parents and Carers

Whilst we have had another very busy and productive week in school, it has been tinged with some apprehension due to the news of the Omicron variant. We are all waiting to understand more about any impact of this and meanwhile remain focused on keeping all elements of school life running smoothly for the children.

Current measures

All of the measures that have been in place this week, will continue next week. Therefore:

- All extra-curricular activities will be in operation.
- Some Key Stage assemblies will take place.
- By prior arrangement, meetings with staff can take place, but a face covering must be worn.
- School meals and packed lunches will continue to be served in classrooms the use of the dining hall brings extensive mixing with no ability to distance or sit other than face to face.
- Parents are requested to wear a face covering when gathering at the school gate.
- Parents and visitors must wear a face covering when entering the school site.
- Parents are asked to distance, when possible, when waiting to enter the site or collecting children.

None of the measures are impacting on the children's education. All measures will be reviewed again next week.

Symptoms, testing and reporting

Please can all families continue to be vigilant for symptoms of Covid-19 and seek a PCR test when required. A PCR test is required when symptoms are known. Please can parents continue with twice weekly LFD testing to identify asymptomatic cases of Covid-19. The outcome of all tests, whether positive or negative, must be reported, please, to the school office at enquiries@newbridge.bathnes.sch.uk

The Nativity

Please know that a final decision is still to be made about what can be achieved with the Nativity performance, led by Year 2, next week. Contingency plans are in place if the full performance for the lower school does not happen. Many considerations must be made with the primary one being minimising the transmission of Covid-19, and potentially the new variant, which would mean all close contacts would be required to isolate for ten days. Decisions like this are not straightforward and we ask for your understanding and support at this uncertain time. Updated information will be shared at the start of next week.
