Uniform and dress code

Asymptomatic testing for parents and adults in households with children at school or college

NHS Test and Trace announced last week that parents and other adults in households with children at school or college, who do not have symptoms, can now access regular, rapid coronavirus (COVID-19) testing. This includes childcare and support bubbles. Please follow this link for all information https://www.gov.uk/guidance/rapid-lateral-flow-testing-for-households-and-bubbles-of-schoolpupils-and-staff and make reference to the information attached from Public Health.

Testing is voluntary, but strongly recommended to all who are eligible.

Symptoms of Covid-19

The school must be informed as soon as possible of a pupil having Covid-19 symptoms, and that siblings of pupils with symptoms are not sent to school. These are:

- A high temperature: any new high temperature where your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to measure the temperature).
- A new continuous cough: coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours.
- A loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste: a noticeable loss of smell or taste or things smell and taste different to normal.

If anyone has any of the symptoms they should isolate at home, along with household members, and request a PCR test. Please can I ask that the result of a test, positive or negative, is reported to the school office as soon as it is received. If the result is negative, your child, and any siblings, can return to school immediately.

- Click on 'Sign Up' and after entering your email address and phone number, you will receive a text message with a PIN number for logging into your School Gateway account.
- When signing in, click on your child's name and then 'payments'.
