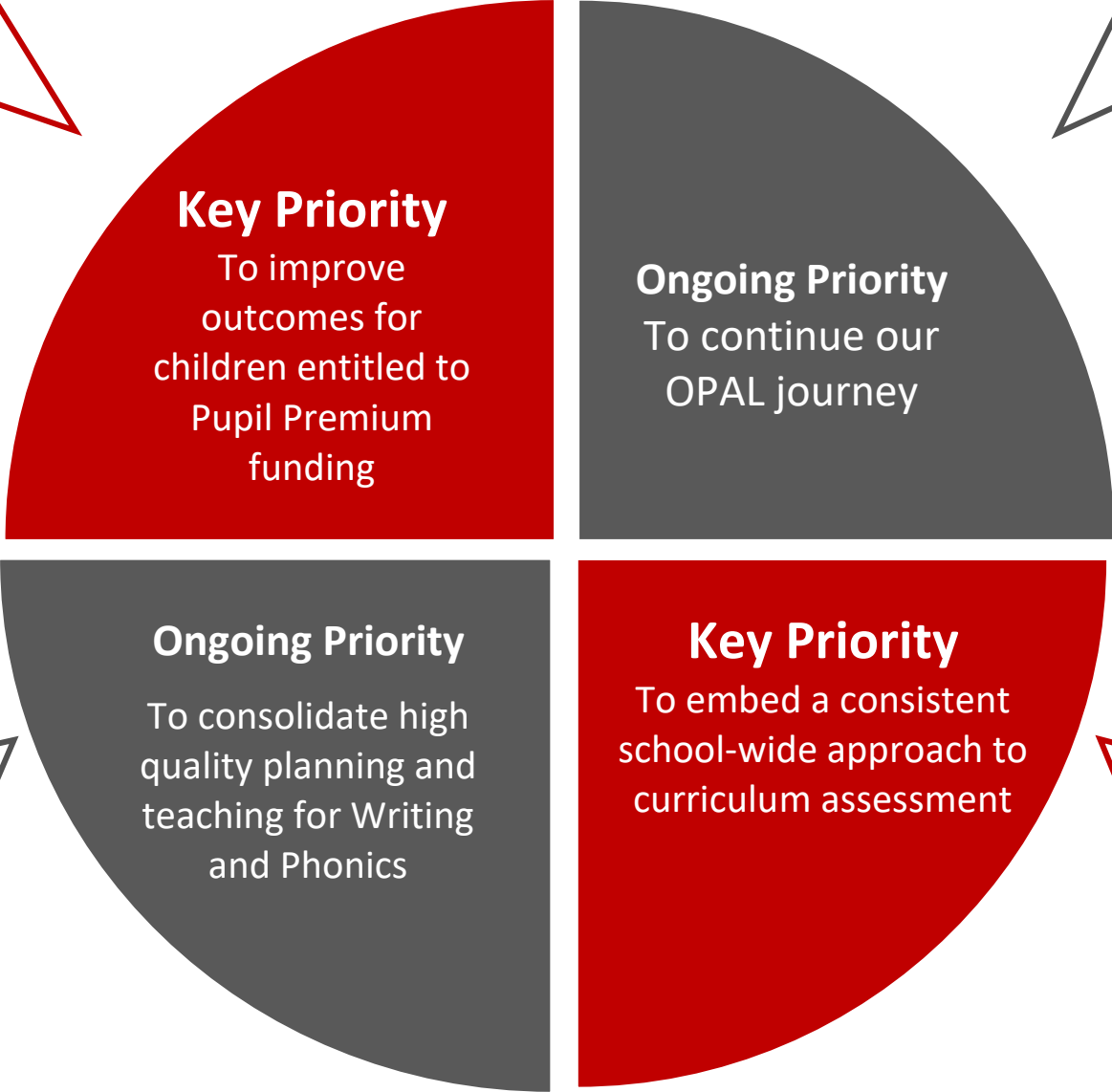


Newbridge Primary School
