<p>Daily English</p>	<p>This week we would like you to create a story where you can use settings, characters and atmosphere.</p> <p>Today we would like you to continue writing the middle of your story. Try to include an exciting event, dialogue and powerful language. Can you include our whole class reading words or ones that you have found in your own reading?</p>
<p>Well-being</p>	<p>Tomorrow it's Feel Good Friday (FGF): Good mental health allows children and young people to develop the resilience to cope with whatever life throws at them and now couldn't be more relevant a time. This term in Personal Social and Health Education (PSHE) we have been following our scheme of work called JIGSAW. The jigsaw piece is titled "Healthy Me". We would like to create a 'Happy Healthy Newbridge Newspaper'.</p> <p>We want nothing but positivity and happiness to shine through everything we do today and tomorrow. See below for the challenge for each year group. (Please don't overload yourself trying to get this work done as well as all the other work you have been set – why don't you substitute it for another. We have sent this today so you can prepare this work or do over a couple of days.)</p> <p>You are going to write an article for the 'Happy Healthy Newbridge Newspaper'. This will be based on something that you did last week at PGL. We'd like you to think about an activity where you used TEAMWORK to complete the activity. (If you didn't go to PGL, think of another time where you used teamwork to complete a mission.)</p> <p>THIS MAY TAKE A FEW DAYS TO DO.</p> <p>Don't forget the success criteria for writing a news report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is there a catchy headline? • Is the report written in the past tense? • Does the first paragraph include the most important information? Who? What? When? Where? • Does the rest of the report include more detail about how and why? • Is it written in the third person? • Is there a quote in speech marks? • Is the report written in chronological order? (Time order) • Does the last paragraph speculate what will happen in the future? • Is there a picture with a caption?
