Reading

Enjoy reading your book today for 10 minutes. Have a go at challenging yourself with some questions to support your understanding.

Create a list of any words you don't know the meaning of and have a guess at what they could mean. At the end of the story, go back and discuss their definitions.

Top Tips:

Prior to reading, encourage your child to focus on the title of the book, the author, the illustrator and the front cover. Make predictions about what you think will happen in this book based on these factors. Afterwards, read the blurb and see if it gives you any further hints.

Continue asking your child questions throughout the book but also encourage them to ask questions as this will further their understanding of the text.

When you have finished the story, is your child able to retell the events in the order in which they happened? If you are reading non-fiction, can they recall any interesting facts that they have read?

Counting, number bonds or times tables

Count in 2s forwards and backwards to either 10 or 20.

Challenge: Can you count on to either 50 or 100?

Maths	<p>Day 1: Select 3 numbers between 0 and 10, ask your child to write addition number sentences using the numbers. How many different number sentences can you make? How do you know when you've got all of the possible number sentences? Then represent the addition sentences pictorially too.</p> <p>Challenge: Select numbers up to 20 instead.</p> <p>Day 2: Select 3 numbers between 0 and 10, ask your child to write subtraction number sentences using the numbers. How many different number sentences can you make? How do you know when you've got all of the possible number sentences? Then represent the subtraction sentences pictorially too.</p> <p>Challenge: Select numbers up to 20 instead.</p>
English	<p>Day 1: Dictated sentence: Please read the sentence to your child. Then re-read slowly one word at a time while your child writes the sentence.</p> <p><i>I found a red box of big gold coins.</i></p> <p>Challenge: Can you extend your sentence using and/because/when?</p> <p>Phonics Game – Please visit phonicsplay.co.uk and select one of the free Phase 3 games to play with your child. If you want to make it either easier or more difficult you could try a Phase 2 or 4 game instead.</p> <p>Day 2: Dictated sentence: Please read the sentence to your child.
