

## **Spelling Lists - Year 5 Term 4 2023**

These are the spelling patterns that will be covered in class this term. In Year 5 and 6, as preparation for the end of KS2 SATS, there will be spelling tests to practise and gain familiarity with the format of these assessments. We would also like you to look at the patterns at home and find other words which use the same spelling pattern. The children could explore other forms of the word: e.g. treasure - treasured, treasuring.
