Learning

Supporting your child

Reading at home: - this is imperative and needs to be done nightly to build stamina in preparation for secondary school.

Spellings: have been given out and are also available on the website. The children will be tested weekly on a Friday. Please continue to practise times tables every week to ensure fluency to support the Year 6 maths curriculum.

Water bottles, waterproof coats, reading books and reading record books should be brought to school every day. In Year 6, children do not need to bring in their own pencil cases as equipment is provided.

Please ensure all items of clothing and belongings are named.

P.E.

Our days are **Thursday** and **Friday** and children should come into school in their PE kit. Long hair must be tied back (as it should be in class) and earrings must be removed or covered with tape provided from home.

Inhalers
