



This is a wonderful day in school where we champion children's reading choices and promote a love of reading for pleasure. For our World Book Day celebrations 2024, we will have a whole school focus on the amusing and

unusual text 'The Book with No Pictures' written by B. J. Novak. As part of our shared story times, we will celebrate the excitement and pleasure of reading as a school community. This focus will also link to other activities during the school day, including creative activities based around the book's unique style and allowing children to use their own imaginations to create their own nonsense words and characters, making their own books and writing their own stories. Additionally, our Year 6 children will read with their Reception 'buddies', so we build on



the fantastic work they have been doing as positive role models for our youngest children. If there is a particular book that your child enjoys reading at home we are inviting them to bring that book into school to show class members, so that hopefully children (or indeed us!) might find a book that they haven't thought about reading and choose to read



that book in the future. To promote a love of reading your child has brought home tonight a book token which can be exchanged at Tesco, Asda, Sainsbury's and The Works, for one of this year's chosen books, maybe you and your child will discover a new favourite! We have decided not to run a fancy-dress day as we know this can be expensive for families and can detract from the real focus of the day, which is changing lives through a love of books and shared reading.



On **Friday 15th March** we will be suuporting **'Red Nose Day'** for a whole day of fun, learning and feel good fundraising! funds for a great cause. **This money is to be paid using ParentPay.** Larger donations can be made and will be greatly received if you wish to do so!


