


VALUE FOCUS - This half-term our value focus is **Aspiration**. We are challenging all the children to ensure:

Kids Night In: On Thursday 13th February, FON are hosting another kids' night in! There will be a choice of films to watch and a choice of food to enjoy. The films will be soon chosen by our school council and all children will then be given the option to pick which they prefer! There will be several **payment items set up on Arbor** so please read the following information carefully.

- Film and food only The cost of the film night and food is £4.50, please make payment on <u>FON Film Night 13.2.25 (HOTDOG)</u> or <u>FON Film Night 13.2.25 (PIZZA)</u> depending on your child's food choice. Please note, food includes hot dog or pizza, crisps and a drink.
- Film, food and popcorn If your child would also like a bag of salted or savoury popcorn, this can be paid for on a separate payment item FON Film Night 13.2.25 with Popcorn (PIZZA) or FON Film Night 13.2.25 with Popcorn (HOTDOG) at £5.50.



• After School Club attendees - For those children who normally attend our paid After School Club on a Thursday, all children will watch the film of their choice but have their usual snack in After School Club, however, if your child would like to have the food provided by FON, please pay £2.50 on the payment item FON Film Night 13.2.25 ASC.

- The main staff car-park is not to be used for drop off at the start of the school day or pick up at the end of the school day.
- Children attending 8:30am breakfast club need to wait outside the reception entrance so staff starting work can sign.
- Children's' water bottles should contain water and not fruit juice or fizzy pop.
- Children should not bring toys in to school. This includes things such as keyrings and fidget toys. Sensory support needs are to be discussed with Miss Sharrock in her role as SENDCo.
- Earrings should be stud earrings only. Earrings need to be removed for PE days. If children can not remove their own earrings it should be done at home before they leave school.
- Long hair should be tied back each day.
- Reading at home should take place at least three times per week. Thank you for your support it really does make a difference to your child.
