

**Year 3:** This week, year 3 have been learning more about the types of soil that we have around our school. Before half term, we gathered samples from different places around the school and left them to separate over the holidays. This week, we have analysed and drawn the layers to find out what each type is made of and also experimented with which will be best for growing our tomato plants.











We have now received the final draft of our Ofsted report following the inspection that took place on Wednesday 1st and Thursday 2nd May 2024. We are extremely pleased that the report recognises the improvement from the previous report for Northbrook Primary School (prior to joining Endeavour Learning Trust) when the school was judged inadequate in all areas. We are

also pleased that the inspectors recognised that school leaders fully understand what needs to be done to continue the clear improvement journey.
