This week in Year 1 we have been learning about penguins for our English unit. We took an iPad and went looking for the different penguin facts that Mrs Wilson had hidden around school. The children could read the



facts and then take pictures of the facts to help remember them.

In Year 3, we kick started our new English genre, by exploring the features of a fable. We learnt that a fable was a short story, typically with animals as characters, conveying a moral. We then listened to a fable, listening closely for sounds that may give us a clue what was happening in the story.
