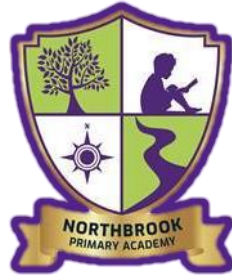

- **Sunday 1 September 2024** - Apply from this date
- **Wednesday 15 January 2025** - National closing date for primary applications (statutory).
- **Wednesday 16 April 2025** - Offers issued to parents

A few reminders...
